What: Road closure for carriageway resurfacing
Where: Innsworth lane – see overleaf for details of the exact location
When: 24th – 28th April
Time: **Section 1:** A40 to Little Normas will be closed 0900-1500 daily
Section 2: Little Normans to Longford Lane will be closed 0730 to 1730 daily (Please see plan overleaf)

On behalf of Gloucestershire County Council, Amey will shortly be resurfacing the road at the above location.

To ensure the safety of road users and our workforce, it will be necessary for us to **close the road** because of the road width and machinery that will be used. To help minimise the disruption to residents of Little Normans, we have shortened the hours of the road closure between the A40 and the entrance to Little Normans to 0900-1500 daily. Please see the map overleaf for full details.

We hope you understand that we will not be able to guarantee access for vehicles in or out of our work area (solid red line on map overleaf) except in emergencies. If you normally drive into or out of this area during the hours when the closure will be in place, we ask you to please make alternative arrangements. Please also avoid leaving parked vehicles on the road. Pedestrian access will be maintained throughout.

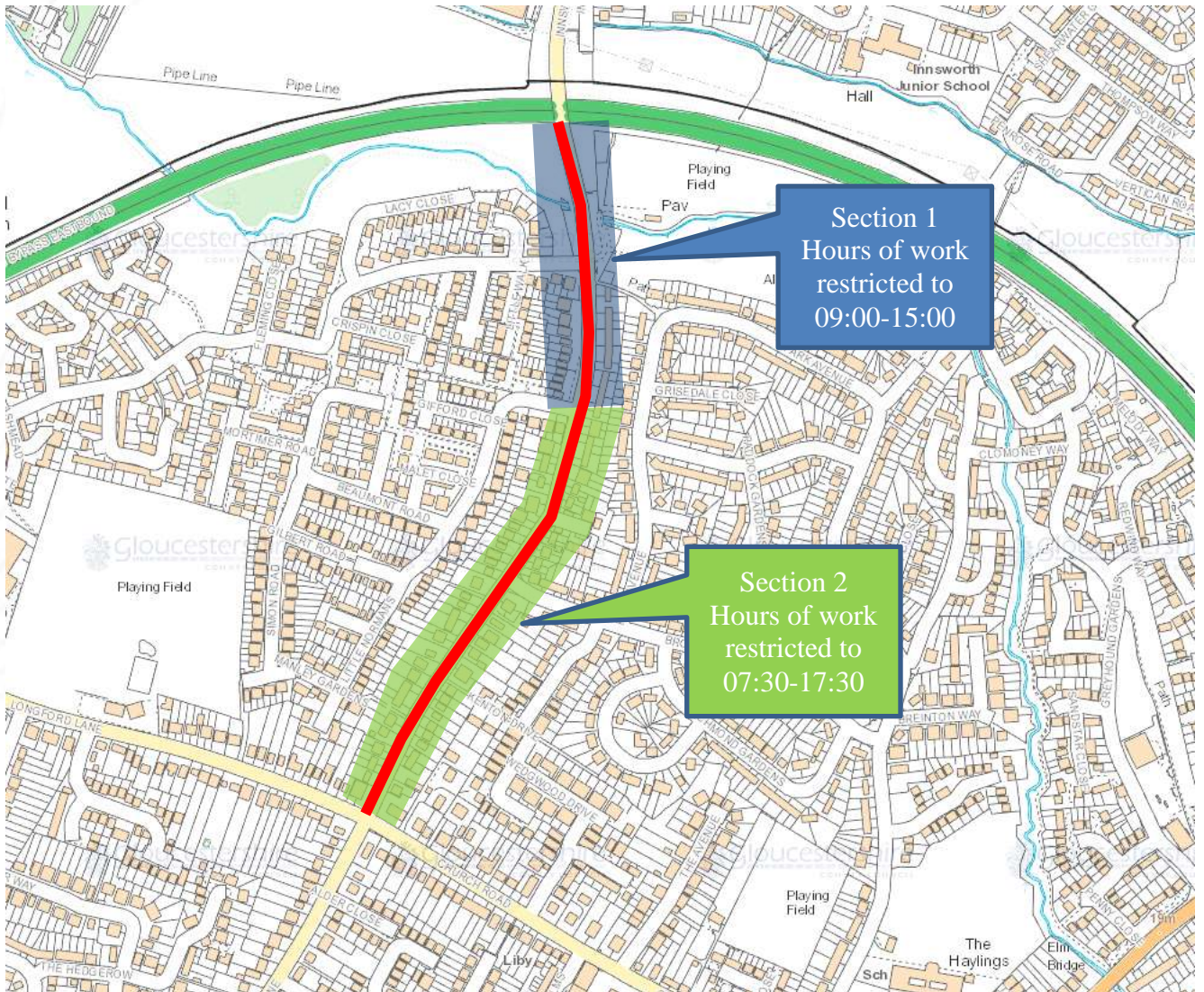
