School Ski Trip 2020

We are pleased to announce that the 2020 Sir Thomas Rich's School Ski Trip will be returning to the beautiful resort of Nassfeld in Austria in February 2020. The visit is planned to take place from **Friday 14 to Saturday 22 February 2020** and falls entirely within the school half-term holiday.

Nassfeld is one of Austria's top ski resorts, offering impressive mountain panoramas as well as fun on more than 110 kilometres of pistes. All students, from **beginners to advanced**, will find both easy and challenging experiences on a great variety of slopes.

Students will receive ski tuition each day with first class instructors, amongst some of the most breath-taking scenery in Europe. Participation in this trip is a great opportunity for students to build on their relationships with staff and other students, develop lasting friendships and return with new found confidence.

In order for the trip to take place, it must be self-financing, and so we invite you to make a contribution of **£979 per pupil to cover the costs*.** If your son is in receipt of the Pupil Premium grant, the cost of this trip may be covered. This includes return travel by executive coach and ferry, six nights' full board and accommodation at the Jugendsporthotel Leitner hotel. Fully comprehensive travel insurance (including medical, travel delay, personal liability and 24-hour emergency service) is also included as is a six-day lift pass, five hours ski tuition a day and the hire of skis, boots, poles and helmets as well as a range of evening entertainments. The only extra cost will be for meals during the journey from Sir Thomas Rich's School to Austria and any pocket money you may wish your child to have.

Whilst we have tried to keep cost to an absolute minimum and have negotiated a discount, we are aware that this is an expensive trip and we have tried to give as much time as possible to make the payments. The instalment plan is set out below:

It is important that we adhere to this timetable as late payments to PGL may result in penalty charges. If there are any problems, then please contact us as soon as possible.

For an additional charge, the School organises a programme of tuition, based on ability, at Gloucester Ski and Snowboard Centre. These 90-minute sessions usually take place after School for four consecutive weeks from early November. More details will follow later this month.

Places are limited to 42 students. If you wish your son/daughter to be able to take a place on this visit, please return the attached expression of interest form to the Finance Office** by 19 September with a NON-REFUNDABLE deposit of £100. Please include cash or a cheque with the consent form, in an envelope marked with your son's name and form, and the name of the trip, **Ski trip 2020**.

Should more students wish to take part than there are places to offer, places will be allocated using a "first out of the hat" system providing the application was received by the deadline.
