M5 J11 Golden Valley gyratory repairs

Highways England operates, maintains and improves England's motorways and major A roads. I'm writing to let you know about works in your area.

Works

We are carrying out full refurbishment of the two main bridges that support the M5 J11 Golden Valley gyratory linking the M5 and the A40. The majority of work will be carried out on the north to south bridges. This 18-month scheme will see removal and reconstruction of ballast walls, concrete repairs to the bridge deck, replacement of bridge bearings, removal and reconstruction of parapet edge beams and safety fencing, and finally waterproofing and resurfacing of the carriageway and footpath. Motorists travelling to Cheltenham or Gloucester may wish to consider using alternative junctions to avoid potential delays. Please accept our apologies in advance for any inconvenience or disruption you may experience during this essential safety work.

Dates

Start: 28 September 2020

End: February 2022

Traffic management

The works will be carried out under a full closure of the gyratory. Motorists will be able to join and leave the M5 via the slip roads but will be unable to circle round the gyratory. Whilst these closures are in place a clearly signed diversion will be in place via Arle Court and Elmbridge roundabouts. Please be aware Gloucestershire County Council may have roadworks in place between J11 and Arle Court at the same time.
